How emerging markets are heating up Southern California's construction market

As the Southern California construction market continues its strong rebound, in large part due to foreign and domestic funding sources, we cannot overlook emerging markets in Central and South America. Last year, Ferdinando Guerra, an Economic Development Specialist and Terri Batch, a Senior International Trade Specialist with the U.S. Department of Commerce, spoke about ties between emerging markets and Southern California on a more macro level.
