Prefabrication and modular construction has been growing in popularity in recent years, due to expedited construction schedules, increased safety and better quality control, while also reducing waste and carbon footprint. Additionally, offsite construction can address the current skilled labor shortages in certain markets. A 2019 report by consulting firm McKinsey & Company, estimates that modular construction could grow to a \$130 billion industry in the United States and Europe by 2030. Although this isn't a new process, the practice is gaining significant momentum.
